Mr. Daley:

This Letter of Agreement sets out the understanding between the New Brunswick Department of Post-Secondary Education, Training and Labour (PETL) and the New Brunswick Student Alliance Inc. as to our mutual obligations in regard to the Student Summer Employment component of the Student Employment and Experience Development Program (SEED). The term of this Agreement is from April 7, 2017 to September 8, 2017.

As a third-party validator, the New Brunswick Student Alliance Inc. will confirm that the random selection process used to deliver employment vouchers is conducted by a randomized system to ensure equal opportunity for all students who registered.

PETL will provide information to the New Brunswick Student Alliance Inc. on how the student information is collected, used and randomized as well as how the vouchers will be distributed.

As per the Declaration of Understanding, the New Brunswick Student Alliance Inc. agrees that its representative shall treat as confidential, during, as well as after the rendering of services to PETL, any confidential information to which it becomes privy as a result of its relationship with PETL.

It is understood and agreed that the New Brunswick Student Alliance Inc. and its representatives are not, nor shall they be deemed to be employees, servants or agents of PETL.

Either party may terminate this Agreement without cause by provision of thirty (30) days written notice.



This Letter of Agreement and the Declaration of Understanding contain the entire understanding between PETL and the New Brunswick Student Alliance Inc. and cannot be modified. A new Agreement must be executed by PETL to modify the terms of this Agreement.
